- **A.** Committee will discuss the logistics of a "speed friend-making" event. (10 minutes, action) **David motions to adopt, Zach seconds**
 - 1. Focus group feedback: positive student reactions to idea, (11/10-14 possibly for event), Zach proposes: M-W where majority of students have class and can see the event or Friday where students wont be busy but wont be at school. Buzzyfest feedback: have two days (make two day event), Brenda proposes: 2-4pm or 1-3pm where students dont have class, Luna: proposes snacks for event when cafeteria is full (incentive to ring students to the event). Format of activity: Alyssa proposes to assign

groups based from wrist band colors to avoid awkwardness of 1 on 1 interaction, Brenda proposes hobbies or major, committee agrees to start students off with 1 on 1 --> duo activities --> group activities, Group activity ideas: Zach suggests silly question or problem solving, Jenga or group battle ship is mentioned, Julian proposes ping pong tournament, Spaghetti tower: Luna suggests to start with large group, Julian suggests musical chairs, Joel suggest occupation ice breaker. Possible event time frame: $2-2\ 1/2$ hours, Setting: inside in student center or a room in the 200 building
